SSC PARTNERSHIP WITH HENRY COUNTY RESULTS IN \$750,000 SAVINGS FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT

THE ISSUE:

Henry County is the 8th largest school district in Georgia made up of nearly 200 school districts. Administrators began to explore outsourcing services in order to save in rising employee costs. The districted wanted an easier way to manage their custodial program.

THE SOLUTION:

When Henry County District went out to bid a serious concern within the community was about the job security of the staff working within the district. Throughout the bid process SSC successfully alleviated those concerns by offering the same wages and benefits to all existing team members. This was a huge win to the district, by outsourcing their custodial the schools were able to focus exclusively on the education of their diverse student body.

ONGOING SUCCESS:

After year one of out partnership with Henry County, SSC helped the district save more than \$750,000 in classified benefit costs, all while providing excellent service and earning trust from the local community. With the SSC team fully focused on cleaning and maintaining the schools, the district was able to use the saved budget dollars to make improvements in areas that were instrumental to student success.

Recent Recognitions:

Pre-K classes have been approved at 7 elementary schools. 3 high schools have received Title 1 High-Progress Awards. 9 high schools have been recognized by the College Board as AP Honor Schools.

Henry County has been able to shift their focus into investing in their schools. Renovations are scheduled for several schools throughout the district and two new schools were completed during the 2019-2020 school year.

The decision to partner with SSC has proven to be the right one for Henry County. The district continues to renew their contract with unanimous board approval each time.
